TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION 2021 Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to Anglian Water repairs to a burst water main the use by vehicles of the Well Hall Lane from 410m west of its junction with B1153 Grimston Road for 30m westwards in the PARISH OF GAYTON will be temporarily prohibited from 16th to 23rd September 2021 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 8 days within the period. If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 21 days.

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order)

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
